### HSA Enrollment, Contribution Limits Increase

July, 2011

Just as a new census by America's Health Insurance Plans reveals that enrollment in HSAs jumped more than 14 percent since last year, the IRS issued 2012 cost-of-living contribution and coverage limits for HSAs, most of which have been increased. The amounts are detailed below.
